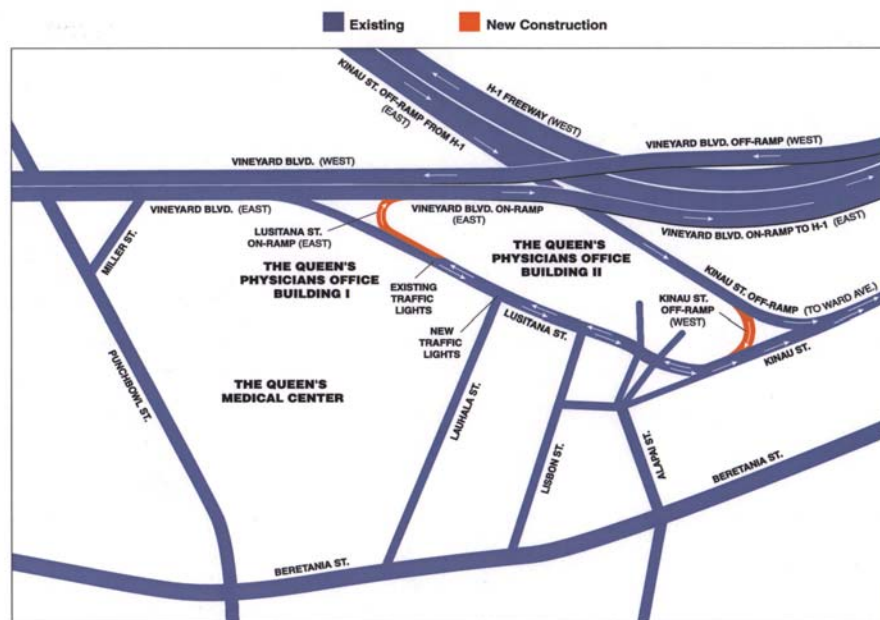
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Project Description & Firm’s Responsibility

The Queen's Medical Center has developed a Ten-Year Master Plan Facilities Development Program in order to improve and modernize its operations. Implementation of the master plan involves improving traffic conditions in the vicinity of the medical center. Roadway improvements are proposed in order to improve existing traffic flow and mitigate potential traffic impacts.

Work included the preparation of an environmental assessment that disclosed potential impacts that could result from development of the project and measures to mitigate these potential impacts.

Construction plans, specifications, and cost estimates were prepared for the roadway improvements. Work included the design of a right-turn lane onto Lusitana Street from the Kinau Street off-ramp and a right-turn lane from Lusitana Street to Vineyard Boulevard.
