**Project Description & Firm's Responsibility**

The City and County of Honolulu has implemented a Community Visioning Program, where the public is given the opportunity to say what they want in their neighborhoods. As part of this program, the City proposes to renovate an old cane haul road to provide a two-way roadway connecting the Village Park Subdivision to Waipahu Town. This roadway would be built across the H-1 Freeway.

Work includes the preparation of an engineering report evaluating three alternative roadway schemes. After review of the three schemes by the City and the Vision Community/Team, the recommended scheme will be presented in a final report. Work also includes the preparation of an Environmental Assessment and a Notice of Determination as Finding of No Significant Impact. Construction plans, specifications, and cost estimates will be prepared in the next phase.
